Working with LLDC to look at vacant spaces in HWFI and find ways to unlock them and put them to use instead of them wasting away

Living Lab research findings:

Z. Zhang:

- Home ownership is unobtainable for most young people
- Current housing expenditure is too much

There is a shortfall of £400pm between average creative sector income and average HWFI rents

- Affordable housing has social benefits
- Unconventional housing is important to most (54% of participants lived in warehouses)
- Neighbourhood quality trumps affordability

The way forward:

- Product mix tailored for different groups of people
- Alternative housing models
- Key worker status for creative practitioners
