- To support the sustainable artist-led regeneration of Hackney Wick and Fish Island
- To protect the availability of affordable workspace for creative practitioners
- To provide a regular forum to facilitate relationship building, partnership forming, sharing of resources and collaboration between all members of the community
- To provide a link between the creative community and local stakeholders: LLDC, LBTH, LBH, and GLA
- To facilitate fundraising, grant applications and public sector financing of the local creative economy
- To bring together a wide range of partners to promote Hackney Wick and Fish Island
- To ensure that the heritage of Hackney Wick and Fish Island informs its future
- To enable the community to take more control of its own future, and develop a genuine legacy for generations to come
- To help create a community that is economically, socially and environmentally sustainable

- To help create a high-quality, well-designed environment that creates a strong sense of identity and belonging and a vibrant public realm
