3 sites across HWFI

190 homes, 36000 sq ft of commercial space Wick First are taking possession of the sites in the new year

- Handover is expected mid 2025
 Partnering with Bow Arts Trust who will be in charge of commercial space, affordable market space and running community events
 - Affordable studios will be delivered in line with Bow Arts Trust current model

Public realm space near the station will be led by the community

<u>J. Norman:</u> Not sure of official number but is around 50%

Affordable tenures are shared ownership and social rent

6 Surge Cooperative - Stephen Shiell

Aims to reanimate the once thriving barge friendly London waterways by creating sustainable community-led moorings for larger boats

- Currently have 43 moorings identified with room for more than 300 boats.
- Community garden for non-human species
- Working with Compost Mentist to make compost toilets

Focus on affordable moorings; build reserves and purchase boats for rental

Working on a new listening space - not a club - for live performances and a chance for artists to connect

<u>Martin:</u> local poet, wanting to connect with community

Old baths are running a heat bank over winter for people struggling in the energy crisis

Also have a safe space for divorced parents to look after their children in

Wick Green - development

There is an application to extend Trowbridge surgery temporarily into Wick Green, which will remove a small children's greenspace.

Lots of objections to this and it is being taken to the planning committee.

Cannot go ahead

<u>W. Chamberlain:</u> Creative Wick have recently launched our <u>2023 Music Incubator</u> so would be good to connect
